

## JAMIE FARR OWENS CORNING CLASSIC COURSE ASSIGNMENTS

Thanks again for your help with the JFOCC. Attached are the times and course assignments for the week.

We are required to wear uniforms and have our credentials visible at all times while we are on the course. Uniforms consist of the shirts/hats provided by JFOCC and navy blue (NO DENIM) shorts, pants, capris. NO short shorts allowed. It is highly recommended that you wear tennis shoes as we will be walking quite a bit. Cell phones are not to be used on the course. You may have them but keep them on silent or vibrate and use them while in the volunteer tent.

AWBB volunteers will park in the "B" lot located at Brint and Centennial. A shuttle bus will bring you to the course. Please arrive at the parking lot 10-15 minutes before your shift to allow for shuttle transportation.

When you arrive at the course please meet with one of the Directors (Danielle Schroeder, Jeanne Taylor or Kevin Sarver) at the Volunteer Tent to get your golf cart. The tent is located between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> tees. This is where you can go at **any time** during your shift to take a break, get a snack and cool off.

If your name falls under "Parking Lots" you will make 2 trips per shift out to the parking lots to empty the trash. A truck has been provided by JFOCC to go to the lots. Parking lots are located at Brint and Centennial; United Church across the street and Pacesetter Park. If you are assigned to the parking lots please see a Director for details. This is a very easy assignment and only takes about 10 minutes or so to complete. You will also be assigned to a portion of the course when you are not at the parking lots.

Volunteers are divided into two groups. If your name falls under Group 1, you will cover the following holes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10, 11 and 18. Group 2 will cover holes: 6, 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17. Please refer to your volunteer handbook for the course map.

Due to the limited number of volunteers from Monday-Thursday it was necessary to have everyone be responsible to cover the entire course.

Those of you working the clean-up day will be disposing of the trash cans (if they are still on the course). If all the trash cans have been picked up then you will be assisting the JFOCC in any way to complete the clean up of the entire course.

Please consider the time of year and the conditions we will be working in. You may want to carry sunblock, bug spray and even some hand sanitizer with you. These items are available for purchase at the pro shop but I would recommend you bring it with you.
